Your Itinerary

April 9: Depart USA

April 10: Arrive in Shannon, Ireland, by 7 a.m. Meet your driver/guide in the airport's arrivals hall after clearing customs. Begin the journey to County Kerry. Stop en route in the village of Adare for tea and scones. Upon arrival into Killarney, visit and tour Muckross House & Gardens. Remainder of afternoon and evening will be free to explore the town independently. Dinner is included at your hotel tonight.
Overnight: Killarney Towers Hotel, Killarney (DBB)

April 11: **GOLFERS: 1 round at Tralee Course**

After dropping off the golfers, enjoy scenic touring around the Dingle peninsula. Visit the Gallarus Oratory and explore Dingle town for shopping and lunch. Pick up the golfers and return to Killarney for dinner at your hotel (included).
Overnight: Killarney Towers Hotel, Killarney (DBB)

April 12: **GOLFERS: 1 round at Ballybunion Old Course**

Drive north with the golfers and either visit Limerick and the Cliffs of Moher, or stay in Killarney and do a little shopping. Admissions for this day are not included. Please discuss your preference with your driver in advance. Dinner is included at your hotel tonight.
Overnight: Killarney Towers Hotel, Killarney (DBB)

April 13: Drive east to County Cork. Visit Blarney Castle and gain the gift of gab by kissing the stone located in the battlements of the castle. Enjoy a little shopping at the woolen mills. Drive to the quaint seaside fishing village of Kinsale for lunch on your own before returning to your hotel for dinner included. Remainder of evening is free.
Overnight: Imperial Hotel, Cork (DBB)

April 14: Journey north to the vibrant city of Dublin. Stop en route for a visit and tour at the Rock of Cashel. Arrive in Dublin and have free time to explore the pubs and enjoy the nightlife! Dinner will be on your own this evening.
Overnight: Camden Court Hotel, Dublin (BB)

April 15: **GOLFERS: 1 round at Portmarnock Old Course**

After dropping off the golfers, visit Malahide Castle. Upon arrival back to Dublin, enjoy a sightseeing tour. Remainder of afternoon is free to shop along Grafton Street, stop in the Guinness Storehouse for a pint and a tour, or visit Trinity College to view the Book of Kells. That evening, enjoy dinner and entertainment with live music and dancers.

April 16: Depart Dublin for return flight to USA.
